- ⇒ Watching and getting involved in Tiwi Bombers training sessions.

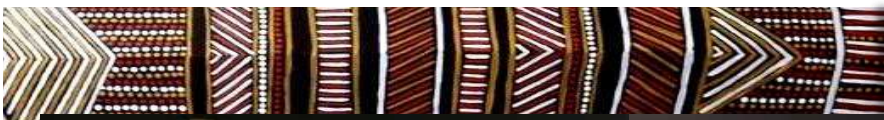
